



– Google Android Quick Setup Guide

This is a configuration guide for connecting a Google Android device (version 4.2 and below) to the UMass eduroam wireless network.

If you are using an Android device running version 4.3 (Jellybean) or above, follow the instructions over the page.

If you are not from The UMass President's Office you will need to contact your home institution for assistance.

Steps for Google Android 4.2 (and below)

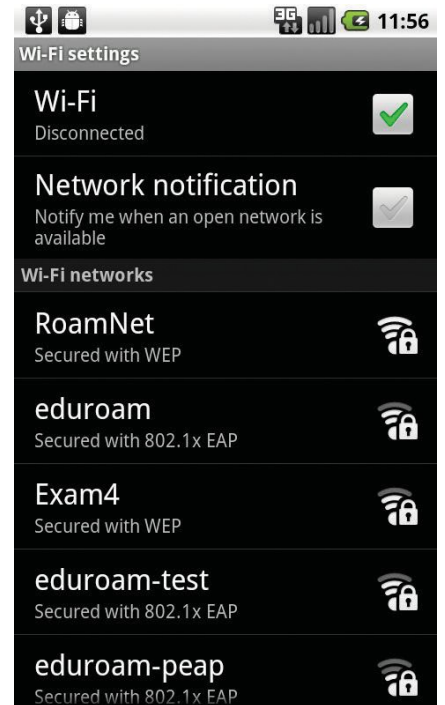
(Android devices vary and the process may look slightly different on your device)

1. Navigate to the Wi-Fi settings window: **Settings > Wireless Controls > Wi-Fi Settings**

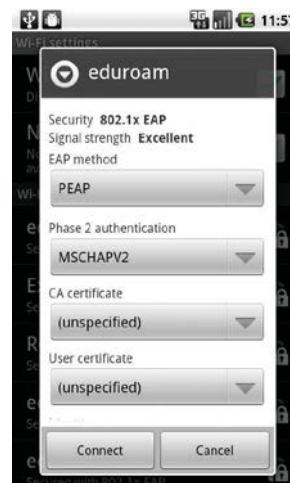
Note: If this is the first time you are setting up a wireless network on your device, you may be asked to 'set a password for credential storage'. This is a **local** password you set on your phone and is not related to your UMass password. If you previously set a credential storage password and cannot remember it, repeatedly enter the wrong password, ignoring any warning messages (you will not lose any data). It will then ask you to set a new password and you can carry on with the eduroam setup.

2. Select **eduroam** from the list of wireless networks and enter the following details.

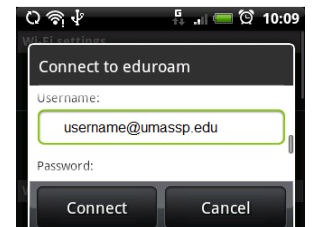
PEAP Method	PEAP
Phase 2 Authentication	MSCHAPV2
Identity	Enter your UMass email address. It must be in the format username@umassp.edu (e.g. jdoe@umassp.edu)
Anonymous Identity	anonymous@umassp.edu
Wireless Password	<your password>
