Chair Manning convened the meeting at 10:00 a.m., stating that there would be two candidate interviews held today for the Presidential Search and four to be held on April 14, 2015.

The Chair then asked for a motion to enter into executive session as permitted under chapter 30A, section. 21(a)(8) to permit the consideration of applicants for employment by this preliminary screening committee as he had determined that an open meeting will have detrimental effect on the ability to attract qualified applicants; and under section 21(a)(7), to comply with the Public Records law, Chapter. 4, section 7, clause 26(u) to protect proprietary information provided to the University to assist in the preliminary screening of applicants. The meeting will not reconvene in open session.
