T18-056 or described in the Approved Capital Project list, as reviewed and amended quarterly, to authorize the President of the University and such other officers of the University as the President may designate (the President and each such other officer referred to herein as an "Authorized Officer"), each acting singly, in the name and on behalf of the trustees, the University or the Commonwealth, as appropriate, (a) to effectuate the financing of one or more or all of such projects by such means as such Authorized Officer shall deem advisable, including without limitation by making a written request in the name and on behalf of the trustees that the University of Massachusetts Building Authority initiate and undertake any such project in the Approved Capital Project list, or to request the Worcester City Campus Corporation to effectuate the financing thereof through any appropriate issuer of debt, and, (b) in connection with any such financing, to take such actions (including without limitation the execution of the guaranty of the Commonwealth on any obligation guaranteed by the Commonwealth), secure such governmental approvals, execute such agreements (including without limitation contracts for financial assistance, management and services, contracts for management and services or leases or subleases) containing such provisions and provide for such terms and sources of repayment, all as such Authorized Officer shall deem advisable and as may be required or permitted by law, including without limitation St. 1960, c. 773, § 19A, as amended, and St. 1992, c. 138, §\_15A, as inserted by St. 2000, c. 159, §\_303.
