I'm very pleased to share that the search has gotten off to an excellent start, and even prior to sharing the position profile, we have received expressions of interest from a significant number of highly qualified candidates which is a testament to the incredible work accomplished by the faculty, students, and staff at UMass Chan.

I want to thank all of you for your continued engagement with the Search Committee over the last several weeks. We have received and processed all of the feedback that you have shared with us, whether it was in-person at our listening sessions, through the online feedback form on the Search Committee's website, or directly with our partners at the search firm, Isaacson, Miller. Your contributions have helped us develop a more complete understanding of the medical school and its community, which will be instrumental in our efforts to recruit another world-class leader – something that we all deserve.

To that end, we wanted to provide an update on the process. The Search Committee met earlier this week, where we voted to approve the UMass Chan Chancellor Position Profile.
