Where Can I Find My Benefits Information?

MyGICLink Benefits Portal-provides you access to all your GIC benefits, including health insurance, basic and optional life insurance and long-term disability. You must be registered to access the portal. The portal also allows you to make changes online during open enrollment or when you experience a qualifying event. You can also update beneficiaries online or apply for additional life insurance or long-term disability at any time during the year (requires medical underwriting if outside your 21-day new hire period).

MetLife Non-Unit Dental Plan through BHE (Board of Higher Education) - provides you details on the dental plan summary and access to print out a temporary card.

<u>UMass Compass/Corestream Voluntary Benefits</u>-provides you access to the discounted auto and homeowner's policies through Farmers, Liberty Mutual and Travelers, as well as the Allstate identity theft protection program and the MetLife Legal plan. You can also access thousands of discounts on products and services on the Corestream website. If you have any of these voluntary benefits, you can register on the Corestream portal and see your deduction detail.

<u>Your Pay Advice in HR Direct</u>-provides you a quick snapshot of deductions, taxes, and your accrual balances. It is good practice to review your pay advice as well as all your personal information on a regular basis to ensure accuracy.
